EXIT M32 at Junction 3 take the A4320 exit to Bath/A4.

At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Easton Way/A4320, keep left and stay on Easton Way/A4320, at Lawrence Hill roundabout take the 2nd exit onto St Phillips Causeway/A4320, at the roundabout take the 2nd exit and stay on St Phillips Causeway/A4320, at the roundabout take the 3rd exit and stay on St Phillips Causeway/A4320.


